- Ties decided highest placing, priority given to Southside Sprint race
- Omnium Presentation shortly after conclusion of each race on Sunday
- Rider must be present on Sunday for prizes, no prizes will be mailed
- Organizer has discretion to make changes prior to event

- Non-MN riders welcome, but don't qualify for MN State Championship
